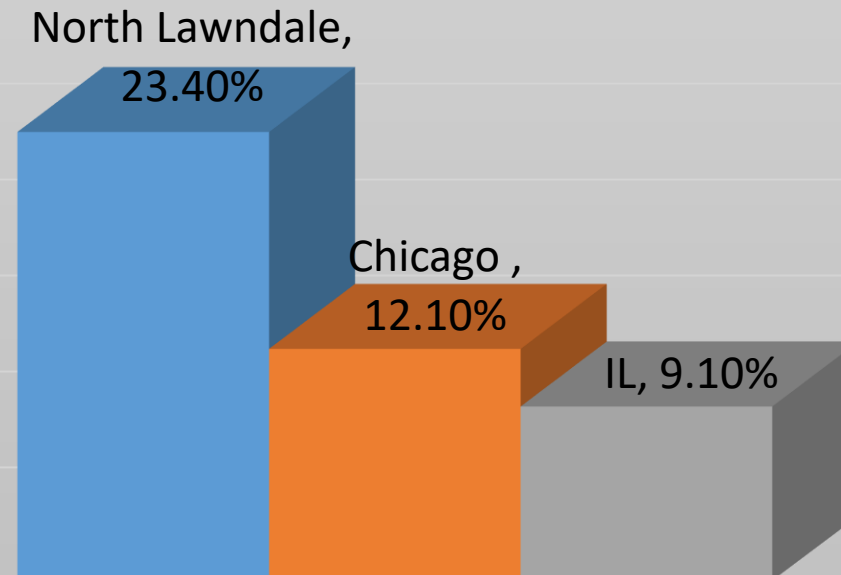

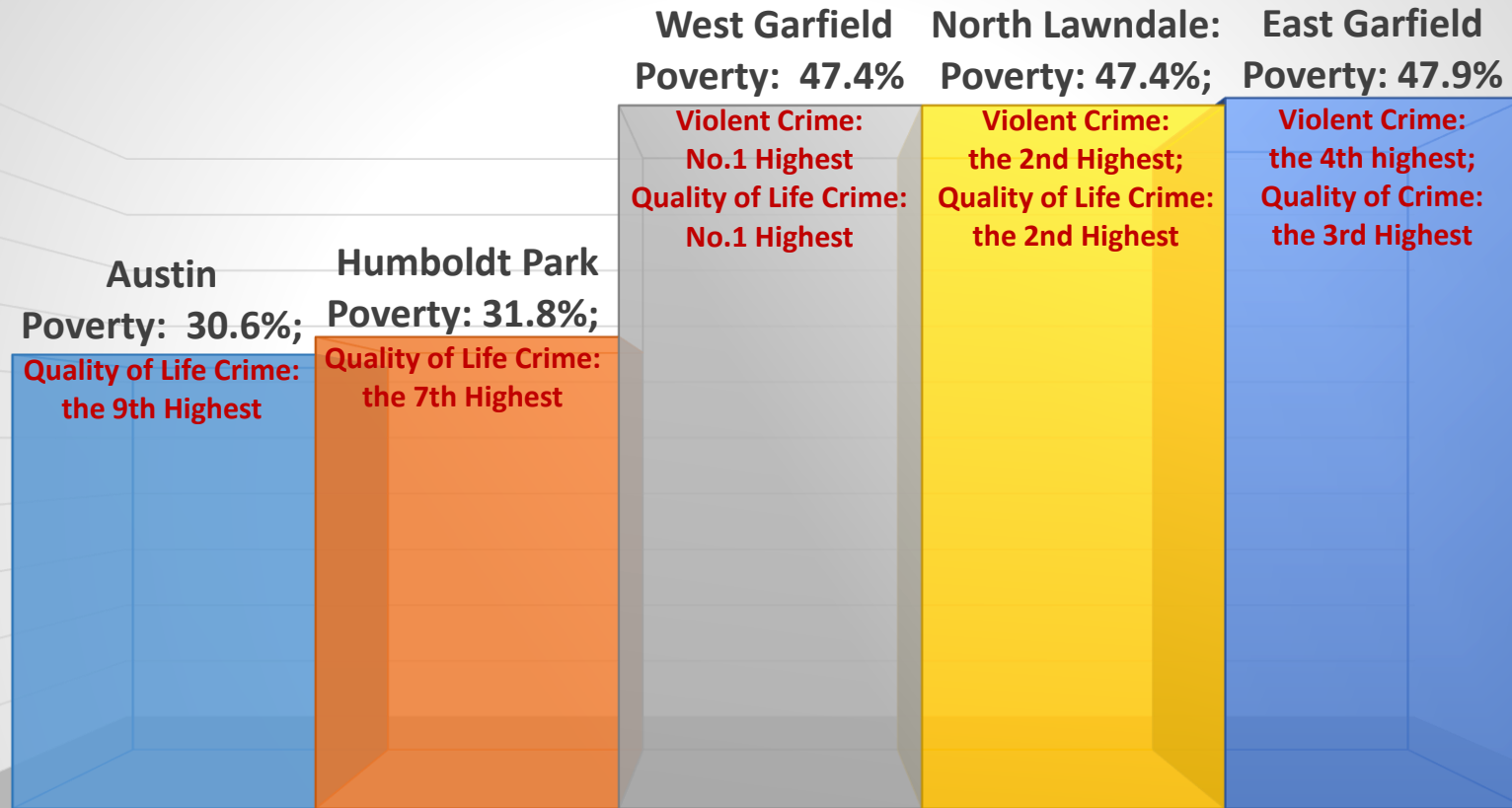


Unemployment Rate for Population 16+
